Image of concealment, container and secrecy_veiling implies secrecy, women's bodies cannot be treated as fully public, secrets be let out if they were open to view. Yet in presenting something inaccessible and dangerous , an invitation to know and to possess is extended.

It furthers the understanding that Gender in Architecture is not a question of looking at how sexuality acts out in a space but rather to ask how is the question of space already inscribed in the question of sexuality.
